SYMPTOMS OF SEPSIS

- » Feels abnormally cold to touch
- » Looks mottled, bluish, or has very pale skin
- » Has a rash that does not fade when pressed
- » Fever
- » Is breathing very fast
- » Has a convulsion
- » Is very lethargic or difficult to wake up



WHAT CAN CAUSE SEPSIS?

- » ANY Infection
- » Open and infected wounds
- » Urinary Tract Infections
- » Ear Infections
- » Pneumonia
- » Meningitis
